As highlighted in the tabling of the 2023/24 Budget Vote, MEC for the Limpopo Department of Cooperative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA), Mr Basikopo Makamu is all out to ensure that all delayed construction projects are completed this financial year.

The CoGHSTA MEC visited Marapong in Lephalale on 28 September 2023 to track the progress made on the construction of the Communi-

ty's Residential Units (CRUs) that commenced since 27 March 2017. He further met with construction workers on site to understand challenges that workers are confronted with that impedes the completion of the project.

To indicate a few, construction workers expressed that shortage of building material and non-payment of salaries by sub-contractors are some of the reasons the project is moving at a garden snail pace.
