After Aluwani Ramakavhi (11) and Pfano Munzhelele (07) of Ha-Mutsha Village in the Makhado Local Municipality suffered a great loss and still live in fear as their mother lost her life as result of Gender-Based Violence in 2019.

The two children will soon have something to smile about as the MEC for Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA), Mr Basikopo Makamu and The First Lady Trust's Mme Maggie Mathabatha will officially hand over a much secure and fully furnished house to them.

Both children are under the care of the uncle but still live in fear as the man accused of murdering their mother is currently out on bail and often threatens the family.

The Limpopo First Lady Trust and Zorah Khan Developers came on board and volunteered to build a house for the family.
