CoGHSTA extends a hand to build Theresa Modiba a house.

The MEC for Limpopo Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA), Mr Basikopo Makamu will visit Ms. Theresa Modiba, a single parent from Mentz Village under the Polokwane Local Municipality jurisdiction following a tragic fire that left her and family homeless in August.

The 43-year-old mother whose ten-roomed house was engulfed in flames has survived through the support and help of community members since the incident occurred.

As a gesture from government to rebuild the lives of the family affected by the fire, CoGHSTA in collaboration with Mamondo Construction Company pledged to build them a BNG house (RDP). The foundation trench of the house under construction is prepared with steel reinforcement and it will consist of two bedrooms, a kitchen, living area and an outdoor VIP restroom.
