Charles Semono (37) and his wife who are both blind, live with their 13-year-old mentally ill child at a relative's meagre dwelling, while Philemon Moela (44) and his wife live with their two children aged 2 and 7 in a one roomed house.

MEC Makamu conducted a sod turning ceremony on the two projects in October this, with a promise to hand the houses over once complete to the families before the end of the year.
