Brief history of the Mathabatha chieftainship

The Mathabatha chiefdom originated from Motsolome Mountains under the leadership of Kgoshi Mathabatha. Kgoshi Mathabatha died while the family was still staying at Motsolane Mountains.

After his death the family resolved that his first born son Mogapotji I, should take over as the leader of Mathabatha tribe. They moved from Motsolome Mountains, under the leadership of Kgoshi Mogapotji I and came to settle at Mahlatji. Mogapotji I died while still staying at Mahlatji. He was succeeded by his first born son Moleke I. The family moved from Mahlatji and settled at a place called Setlwane. Moleke I had a child by the name of Mogapotji II, who took over the reign after his death.
