MEC Makamu to pay his last respects to the late Kgoshi Manamane Edward Mogashoa

The MEC for the Department of Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements & Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA), Mr Basikopo Makamu is set to pay his last respects to the late Kgoshi Manamane Edward Mogashoa of Mogashoa Manamane Tribal Authority under the Makhuduthamaga Local Municipality.

During his 52 years of reign over Makgorong, Mošola, Mmaboko and Part of Phase4 villages, Kgoshi Manamane Edward Mogashoa always urged people to make education a priority. He actively championed the delivery of educational facilities, building of bridges, clinics, houses and tarring of roads which assisted the community with jobs and ultimately alleviated poverty.

Since the dawn of democracy in 1994, Kgoshi Mogashoa Manamane participated meaningfully in politics and became a full member of the ruling party. He played a significant role in uniting Traditional Leaders and served as a Chairperson of Local House of Traditional Leaders in the Sekhukhune District.

Kgoshi Mogashoa passed away on the 6th of February 2020 at the age of 82 and leaves behind his three wives, 13 children, 34 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren.
