Limpopo Provincial House of Traditional Leaders Suspends the winter Initiation season

Following the recent extension declaration of the state of Disaster in mid-March 2021 due to Covid-19 Pandemic, the Limpopo Provincial House of Traditional Leaders has resolved to suspend the launch of the Initiation School for the Winter Season until further notice. The decision is informed by the threat of the spread of the Corona Virus Pandemic and to save lives of the initiates. Currently Covid-19 is still with us, even though we are at level 1 of Lockdown, it is speculated that we might enter the third wave of the Pandemic and more people are going to be affected by this Virus.

It is our well thought decision that in Limpopo all Initiation Schools should remain suspended until it is safe for all to can participate in this important passage for young men and women to become responsible adults in the society. We are calling all Senior Traditional Leaders to work hand in hand with government, in ensuring that all stakeholders adhere to the call that all Initiation Schools should not be launched in their communities during the winter initiation season.

We will keep assessing the environment, checking the risks related to Covid-19, and guided by the National Command Council and all the key stakeholders, we will decide on a way forward. As the House, we will continue working with all the relevant stakeholders, Department of Health, South African Police Services in preparation for next Initiation
