**COGHSTA REMAINS ON HIGH ALERT AGAINST TROPICAL CYCLONE ELOISE**

The MEC for Cooperative Governance, Human Settlement and Traditional Affairs, Mr Basikopo Makamu, will lead the Disaster Management team in the Vhembe District Municipality as he visits families that were highly affected by the tropical storm Eloise. To date, 29 houses at Tshakhuma under Makhado Municipality, 1 family at Mbaleni and 1 at Makonde under Thulamela Municipality collapsed due to heavy rains caused by the tropical storm.

VENUE: Tshakhuma village

TIME: 09H00

After Tshakhuma, the MEC will proceed to Mbaleni and Makonde villages respectively. The MEC is coordinating with other sector departments for the relief that the families need urgently.
