The month of April each year marks the start of a new financial year for all government departments. Limpopo Department of Cooperative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA) Member of Executive Committee (MEC), Jerry Ndou tabled the department's 2018/19 budget vote on the 12th of April 2018.

The annual event that took place at the Lebowakgomo Legislative Chambers had CoGHSTA officials, stakeholders and MEC's from sister departments that attended looking nothing short of elegant and classy as per dress code.

In his speech, MEC Ndou outlined that the overall budget allocation of R2,624,006 billion presented on the day would be in a bid to not only promote developmental cooperative governance and support municipalities and traditional leadership institutions but optimally deliver integrated and

"In this financial year 2018/19, we have planned to build and handover 7450 housing units. The figure is inclusive of 6965 Rural Housing Units, 215 CRU, 100 Finance Linked Individual Subsidy Programme (FLISP) and 150 Military Veterans," said the MEC.

As part of the department's commitment to provide tools of trade to Traditional Councils, MEC Ndou added that the department will be continuing with the process of constructing and refurbishing several tribal council offices such Nyavana, Pheeha, Batlhabine, Mmaila, Mphotwane, Mmetja, Hlaneki, Bungeni , Nkidikitlana, Babirwa, Seakamela, Mathabatha, Manthata, Maja, Seloane, Bakopa Rammupudu, Bantwana, Manoke and Matlala Ramoshebo. In conclusion, the CoGHSTA MEC thanked all guests that had graced the august occasion.
