MEC MAKAMU VISITS LEPHALALE MUNICIPALITY TO HAND OVER TITLE DEEDS.

The 24th of April 2026 marked another fruitful day of service delivery for the Limpopo Department of Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA) MEC, Mr. Basikopo Makamu.

Together with Lephalale Local Municipality, Cllr. Aaron Mokgetle, MEC Makamu walked the streets of Marapong Extension 4 to personally hand over 419 title deeds to deserving beneficiaries.

While handing over the title deeds to beneficiaries, MEC

Makamu shared that it was his commitment to build communities and restore dignity to beneficiaries

"For many of these beneficiaries, this title deed is more than just paperwork. It is their long-awaited security, dignity, and pride in owning a place they can truly call home.

An emotional Mmashela Mabula could not hold back her tears after receiving the title deed to her and her late husband's house.

"It was very hard to do any renovations to the house as I did not

have a title deed. Now that I can call this house my own, I will be able to renovate it to my liking," she said.

Limpopo CoGHSTA MEC, Mr. Basikopo Makamu's visit to the Lephalale Local Municipality concluded with site visits to Marapong Community Residential Units (CRU) and Altoostyd Settlement where the construction of 516 units is in progress and 200 houses have been built for beneficiaries of Marapong and Altoostyd respectively.
