TRADITIONAL LEADERSHIP EXPRESSES CHALLENGES AT SALGA PROVINCIAL MEMBERS' ASSEMBLY.

The Chairperson of the Limpopo House of Traditional and Khoi-San Leaders, Hosi Pheni Ngove joined the Premier of the Province Dr. Phophi Ramathuba, Provincial Chairperson of SALGA Cllr. John Mpe and the Deputy Minister of COGTA Mr. Dickson Namane Masemola at the SALGA Provincial Members Assembly at Forever Resort in Bela-Bela from 2-3 September 2025. Under the theme "Developing Resilient Municipalities" the two-day assembly brought together key role players in local government
