ollowing some notable audit outcome improvements in some municipalities in the province, MEC for Limpopo Cooperative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA), Mr Basikopo Makamu together with MEC for Provincial Treasury, Mr Seaparo Sekoati co-chaired a Municipal and Members of the Executive Council (MUNMEC) Meeting at Bolivia Lodge.

Attended by Executive Mayors and Mayors on

the 2 <sup>nd</sup> of February 2023, the meeting's agenda entailed among other things the tabling of Audit Reports, State of Municipal Finances, Provincial Social Stability, 2023/24 Human Settlements Delivery Programme and Councilor Welfare from the Auditor General, Provincial Treasury, Department of State Security, CoGHSTA and South African Local Government Association (SALGA) respectively.
