# 2026 IMBIZO HONORS LIMPOPO MILITARY VETERANS AS FREEDOM FIGHTERS.

The Limpopo Department of Co-operative Governance Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA) hosted the 2026 Provincial Military Veterans Imbizo on 26 February 2026 at Bolivia Lodge.

With about 100 military veterans in attendance, the programme of the day entailed veterans outlining their day to day challenges to Limpopo CoGHSTAMEC, Mr. Basikopo Makamu.

The imbizo also afforded veterans an update on the province's overall

performance and interventions put in place regarding the provision of housing through the Military Veterans' Housing Programme.

Giving his address, MEC Makamu said that Military Veterans are not just a Special Interest Group but founders of the country's freedom.

"We have been on a mission to restore the dignity of our veterans through the provision of quality shelter. Through the Military Veterans Housing Programme (MVHP), 295 units have been

completed in the province since the programme's inception," he reported.

The CoGHSTA MEC further alluded that the Department's commitment to provision of quality houses for Military Veterans is evident in the acceleration of service delivery.

"In the 2025,26 Financial Year, we delivered 75 houses exceeding our initial target of 58," he boasted.
