

THOVHELE NNGWEDZENI ALFRED MPHAPHULI LAID TO REST







The people of Ha-Tshikonelo and surrounding villages came in their numbers to pay their last respect to the late Thovhele Nngwedzeni Alfred Mphaphuli. The funeral service was attended by dignitaries to name a few, MEC for Health in the Province, Dr Phophi Ramathuba, the Executive Mayor of Vhembe District Municipality, Cllr Fridah Nkondo, the Mayor of Collins Chabane Local Municipality, Cllr Shadrack Maluleke, ANC Provincial Secretary who is also the late Thoyhele's brother, Mr Reuben Madadzhe and Traditional Leaders. Thovhele Mphaphuli (Madadzhe the 3rd) (79) was born and bred at

Tshikonelo village and is the great grandchild of Thovhele Vho-Makwarela Mphaphuli (Madadzhe the 1st). He is the eldest son of Thovhele Stefanus Tshikonelo Madadzhe Mphaphuli (Madadzhe the 2nd), who passed on in 1993 after he reigned close to six decades at Tshikonelo area. His mother was the late Vhakoma Vho-Thambatshira Takalani Tshivhase Madadzhe from the Tshivhase dynasty.

(CoGHSTA), Mr Basikopo Makamu delivered a eulogy and said: "We are gathered here today to bid farewell to an exceptional leader who never cowed in the face of challenges.
