

Government visits flood-hit areas.

Ha Mufeba is a village under Makhado Local Municipality near the R578 road, known for its community and educational institutions. The village, like many other areas in Limpopo was heavily affected by the recent floods leaving the village inaccessible, damaged bridges and disrupted essential services. In an effort to monitor and provide relief, the Premier Dr Phophi Ramathuba visited Mufeba and neighbouring villages. Ramathuba was accompanied by the MEC for CoGHSTA, Mr Basikopo Makamu, MEC for Department of Social Development Limpopo, Ms Florence Radzilani, the MEC for Public Works, Roads, and Infrastructure, Mr Ernest Rachoene, the Executive Mayor of Vhembe District Municipality, Cllr Freda Nkondo, the Mayor of Makhado Local Municipality, Cllr Dorcus Mboyi and representatives from other stakeholders. The Premier indicated that the government is currently conducting widespread assessments across all affected districts to provide immediate humanitarian assistance such as food and shelter.
