CoGHSTA MEC MI Kgetjepe will handover 1137 title deeds.

The MEC for Department of Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs, Mr. MI Kgetjepe will conduct Public Participation and handover title deeds as follows:

Venue : Phagameng Ext 10 Sports field, Modimolle Municipality


Modimolle residents will benefit from government's Enhanced Extended Discount Benefit Scheme (EEDBS) which was introduced through the Housing Code aimed at facilitating the transfer of pre-1994 houses to deserving beneficiaries.


Following the Phagameng event the Department will further handover title deeds to:- 129 beneficiaries in Seshogo, 383 in Polokwane Ext 44, 57 in Polokwane Ext 71, 705 in Polokwane Ext 73, 48 in Polokwane Ext 75, 267 in Lebowakgomo, 460 in Tshikota Ext 1, and 137 in Musina-Nancefield.

Since 2007 to date, Province wide, the department of CoGHSTA has successfully transferred 17 782 title deeds to beneficiaries. The department has also cancelled the debts of people who were subjected to 99 years lease agreement which robbed them of their dignity
