Commemoration Day**

The late Kgoši Mampuru II was brutally hanged in public on 22nd November 1883 at Pretoria Central Prison (currently renamed after him by the President, His Excellency, Mr. J.G Zuma on 10 April 2013).

This event aims to keep the spirit of the late Kgoshi Mampuru II alive and gives the community an opportunity to celebrate their heritage and culture.
