The beneficiary, Left Maluleke (58) is a farmworker who for years endured financial hardship in raising his family of eight.

The house has been donated by Ximambani Co - operative after the family has been cradling without a proper habitat. The family currently stays in a two dilapidated thatched mud huts. Owning a decent house has always been a dream for Maluleke and his family.

The handing over of the house to the Maluleke's is part of the Department's efforts to fight poverty and restore the dignity of all previously disadvantaged citizens. The Department also has a strategic goal to ensure that deserving beneficiaries are prioritized and this is done in partnership with relevant stakeholders such as Ximambani Co-operative.
