**MEC Makhurupetje to lay the late Hosi Shitlhangoma James Maluleke to rest**

MEC Makoma Makhurupetje will lay Hosi Shitlhangoma James Maluleke, Senior Traditional Leader of Shigalo Traditional Council within the LIM 345 Municipality to rest.

Following the death of his father in 1987, Hosi Maluleke, affectionately known as “King Stapura” was appointed as senior traditional leader in 1989.

The Shigalo Tribal Community is made up of twenty-five villages. In his governance, Hosi Maluleke constituted 25 Indunas and has actively championed the delivery of services such as access to water, electricity, educational facilities, 2x filling stations, fire station, old age home, drop-in center, clinic, farming projects, computers & sewing projects and houses with relevant stakeholders in uplifting their living standards.

The Shigalo Traditional Council is situated at Shigalo Village and consists of 5 staff members: 1x security guard, 1x cleaner, 1x admin officer, 1x financial clerk and 1x grounds man.
